- Involve all departments for clear communication.

Step 2: Find Capabilities & Hazards

- Consult outside resources such as Chesprocott Health District.
- Discuss different scenarios such as blizzards or a tropical storm & how you would respond.
- Gather employee contacts & any special needs they may have .

- Have an escape route and a "Stay-In-Place" Plan.
- Review the Plan with all staff.
- Get Feedback from staff on the plan & post in all Work Areas

- Practice your plan each year and with new employees.
